Pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the Members of the Arizona Board of Executive Clemency and to the general public that the Board of Executive Clemency is meeting for the purpose of conducting a hearing on **October 2, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. at the ASPCE-Rynning Unit in Florence, Arizona 85132**. This hearing is open to the public. Persons with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation, such as a sign language interpreter, by contacting the Board's office at (602) 542-5656. Requests should be made as early as possible to allow time to arrange the accommodation. The Board may vote to go into Executive Session, which will not be open to the public, to discuss any matter on this agenda pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A) (3) (Discussion or consultation with Board attorney for legal advice). The Board may go into Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A) (2) for discussion or consideration of records exempt by law from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information or testimony that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state or federal law.

**Reprieve/Commutation of Sentence hearing regarding Edward Schad, ADC #40496**

***Description:*** In 1985, Edward Schad was convicted in Yavapai County Superior Court Case No. CR-8752 of one count of First Degree Murder and was sentenced to death. The Arizona Supreme Court has issued a Warrant of Execution. The Arizona Department of Corrections has scheduled an execution date for October 9, 2013. At the Reprieve/Commutation of Sentence hearing, the Board of Executive Clemency may receive information and may consider, discuss and vote on whether to recommend a Commutation of Sentence and/or a Reprieve to the Governor. The Board may invite public comment.
