#### **Reprieve/Commutation of Sentence hearing regarding Clarence Wayne Dixon, ADCRR#038977**

***Description:*** In 2008, Clarence Wayne Dixon, ADC#038977, was convicted in Maricopa County Superior Court Case CR-2002-019595 of First Degree Murder and was sentenced to death. The Arizona Supreme Court issued a Warrant of Execution on April 5, 2022. An execution date has been scheduled for May 11, 2022. At the Reprieve/Commutation of Sentence hearing, the Board of Executive Clemency may receive information and may consider, discuss and vote on whether to recommend a Commutation of Sentence and/or a Reprieve to the Governor.
