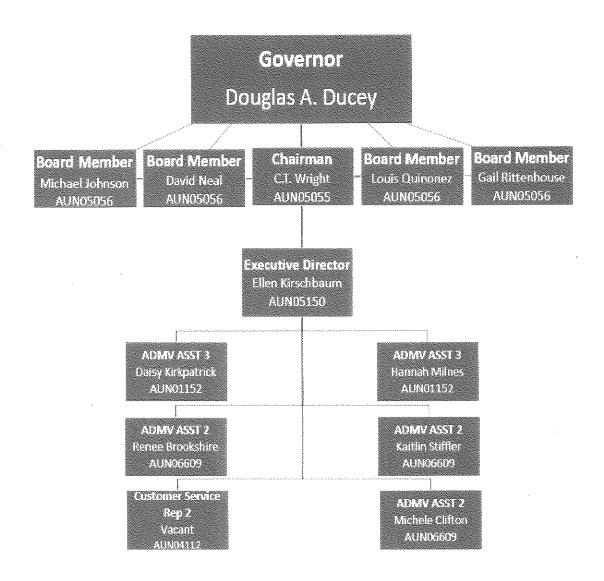

Funding Issue – Hearing Officer

ISSUE CATEGORY: Decision Package

The Arizona Board of Executive Clemency is statutorily mandated to make decisions relating to the revocation of parole or community supervision for crimes committed on or after January 01, 1994, for those found to be in violation of the terms and conditions of their release. Federal law (Morrissey v. Brewer) governs the processes for these hearings. Part of the Court's decision was the right to a probable cause hearing to establish cause or right to take away one's liberty. Presently, the Board does not have budgeted funds for a Hearing Officer position and does not conduct probable cause hearings even when an offender has requested one.

JUSTIFICATION

The Arizona Board of Executive Clemency is a very unique board within Arizona's government structure. Its members work full time conducting revocation, parole, absolute discharge, commutation of sentence and pardon hearings. In FY 2017, 3,110 hearings were conducted by its members. Of the total hearings, 2,391 were parole and community supervision revocations initiated by warrants received from the Arizona Department of Corrections. Of the total warrants received 2,576, 22% or 578 of the offenders requested a probable cause hearing. However, no hearing took place due to the lack funding to hire a Hearing Officer. These requests are continuing to increase as 502 were requested in 2016 and 446 in 2015. This has placed this Board in a position of potential liability with possible mandates from the Court. Without that determination in matters where probable cause is requested, one may conclude that an offender was deprived of due process and his or her liberty was removed longer than necessary.

Historically, legislation has recognized this need for the Board as Arizona Revised Statutes 31-402(G) states:

"The executive director may employ hearing officers as deemed necessary within the limits of legislative appropriation and subject to title 41, chapter 4, article 4. The hearing officers shall conduct probable cause hearings on parole, work furlough and home arrest revocations or rescissions. Hearing officers shall assist the board in making investigations, securing information and performing necessary administrative functions."

Prior to 2002, the Board employed three full-time Hearing Officers, however budget cuts reduced the number to one full-time position. During 2010, additional cuts resulted in a decision to eliminate the funding for this position. The belief was that the Board's revocation hearing satisfied the need of the probable cause hearing. However, this decision has resulted in some of the legal community raising issues of potential deliberate indifference for offenders who have the right to due process. Further, those who may not be violation are held longer until the revocation hearing takes place which results in higher incarceration costs.

In 2014, the Auditor General's sunset review noted a timeliness issue and lack of probable cause determination regarding revocation hearings conducted by the Board. In order to rectify the situation, the Board attempted to hire a Hearing officer for less than 20 hours. The previous Executive Director believed this was not sufficient to accomplish all the duties of the position and made a determination to eliminate any further attempts to provide for probable cause hearings. Funding for a full-time position

was requested in the past but was not appropriated. However, based on the current number of probable cause hearing requests and a more efficient use of board staff to assist the hearing officer, the Board can accomplish these hearings with a .5 FTE Hearing Officer position.

The board's current budget of \$952,600 does not provide adequate funding to hire this position as a .5 FTE. A part-time Hearing Officer could meet the needs of the offender probable cause requests as well as reduce the Board's current liability of not meeting offender due process rights. Additionally, it may help reduce the current costs of incarceration incurred by the Arizona Department of Corrections as inmates must now wait 45 days or more for the Board to conduct the hearing. Therefore, the Board seeks approximately \$33,000 to hire a .5 FTE Hearing Officer commence probable cause hearings to meet compliance with due process within the revoking of an inmate's liberty.

A full time Hearing Officer position is a Grade 20 with a minimum annual salary of \$46,932.08 or \$22.5635 per hour. Based on a .5 FTE, the salary cost, excluding ERE expenses will be \$23,466.04. The total cost including ERE expenses will be approximately \$33,600.

Funding Issue - Board Management

ISSUE CATEGORY: Decision Package

The Arizona Board of Executive Clemency is a very unique board within Arizona's government structure. Its four members and Chairman work full time conducting revocation, parole, absolute discharge, commutation of sentence and pardon hearings. In FY 2017, over 3,000 hearings were conducted by its members. The Board is supported by three (3) Administrative Assistants and two (2) Administrative Assistant IIIs guided by the Board's Executive Director. The Executive Director is responsible for the administrative, financial and operational functions of the Board as well as assisting the Chairman on various board matters such as procedural hearing advice and training of new members. The agency's organizational structure and funding does not provide for a position that allows the Executive Director to delegate managerial responsibilities or continue executive level duties in the absence of the Executive Director.

JUSTIFICATION

The Board is quasi-judicial and an important part of Arizona's criminal justice system. Its members work full time conducting hearings that interact with offenders, their family and friends, attorneys, victims and others to make critical, impacting decisions affecting individuals' lives and community safety. Although its agency size is small, it operates with the same responsibilities and needs of other state agencies.

In July, 2017, the Board's Executive Director resigned after less than two years in the position. It was believed that the individual was disadvantaged by having no knowledge and understanding of the Board's statutory requirements or the operating environment of a Board. With the loss of the Board's only managerial individual, it would have been a serious situation for the Board to continue functioning properly without administrative direction. However, the Board's Chairman stepped in to meet the deadlines of budget, various reports, manage the daily functions and organize a recruitment for the ED position. Because the Chairman had extensive management and Board experience, the agency was able to avoid disorganization and disruption. However, due to the Chairman's schedule with hearings and the potential for conflict as a voting member, this is not a viable alternative to an Executive Director vacancy. The Board interviewed candidates for Executive Director but concluded that none of the candidates had working knowledge and understanding of the Board's function, laws and requirements. Consequently, the Board's Chairman accepted the Board's request to become its Executive Director. This was still a loss for the Board as the Chairman was the most seasoned Board member.

To date, the Board remains in a precarious situation should the current Executive Director become ill or resign. All of the remaining staff positions are non-exempt, line level and do not qualify to accept managerial responsibilities or provide guidance to the Board Chairman or members. Further, all but one of the Board members have less than six months Board experience.

Therefore, the Board believes establishing a managerial position at grade level 24 directly below the Executive Director (E2) provides a succession plan for the continued, successful operations of the Board.

Funding Issue - Board Member Pay Increase

ISSUE CATEGORY: Decision Package

The Arizona Board of Executive Clemency consists of five (5) members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate. Each member may serve a five year term and a chairman is appointed by the Governor for a two year term. Recently, members were granted full employee benefits, effective August 09, 2016, due to the support of our Legislators and Governor Ducey. Prior to that, members were denied leave and holiday pay. The Board now seeks funding for these benefits as well as a compensation that will be more closely commensurate to the work performed.

JUSTIFICATION

The Board of Executive Clemency is very unique and different from other Arizona State Government Boards and Commissions. It is the only board in state government structured to conduct its critical statutory mandates on a full-time basis. It is quasi-judicial and an important part of Arizona's criminal justice system. Its members work full time conducting hearings that interact with offenders, their family and friends, attorneys, victims and others to make critical, impacting decisions affecting individuals' lives and community safety.

The Board is statutorily empowered to make decisions regarding:

- discretionary release of those inmates who are parole and/or home arrest eligible; (inmates whose crime were committed on or before December 31, 1993)
- revocation of parole (or community supervision for crimes committed on or after January 01, 1994) for those found to be in violation of the terms and conditions of their release;
- Absolute discharge from parole; and
- Modification of release conditions and release rescissions.

In addition, members also make clemency recommendations to the Governor on requests for:

- Commutation of sentence, including death penalty sentences;
- Reprieves in matters related to death penalty cases; and
- Pardons.

The members carry out their duty with the flexibility to address the unforeseen challenges and make decisions free from political influence. Its members are professionals and their collective experience and commitment to criminal justice ideals keep the Board committed to long-term as well as short-term public-safety decisions for Arizona. All hearings are conducted in quorum, in the public arena, and require the ability to orate publicly and confidently. A member must be able to understand and apply law, comprehend policy and procedure and make complex decisions based on facts and testimony. Before participating in hearings, members are statutorily required to go through an intensive, four week training program. Every day, a member or the collective Boards' decisions place members in public scrutiny and even a precarious and potentially dangerous environment. Members must convey their decisions to multiple demographics and resist influence and pressure from various stakeholders such as victims, inmate advocates, attorneys and community members. The Board's work requires individuals who are well established in experience and qualifications to meet the daily physical and emotional rigours of the work. A high level of critical thinking and decision making is demanded in determining if an inmate has been rehabilitated for release. On an average day, members will hold approximately 20 hearings. Depending on the visibility and complexity of the criminal matter, a hearing can vary greatly in time.

Once members complete the daily hearing calendar, they must read and analyze case information to prepare for the following day's hearings.

In comparison to their counterparts in other states, members are underpaid. A survey conducted a year ago indicated the average Board member salary was approximately \$68,000. Additionally noted, in many jurisdictions the responsibilities of a Chairman was recognized with a higher salary than their fellow members. Presently, board members are classified in Grade 23 as "Board Member" and compensated at the rate of \$23.4769 per hour or \$46,932.08. A review of colleagues performing the same work in other states indicate a much high compensation rate. Yet many of the other state boards do not have the same degree of responsibility of the Arizona Board of Executive Clemency. This past year, the Board experienced lengthy periods where one or more Board seat was vacant which resulted in significant interruptions in the Board's calendar. Much of this may be attributed to recruitment difficulties based on time commitment and salary. It is strongly believed that the current Board member pay greatly diminishes the Governor's ability to attract qualified citizens as board members unless they already have another fixed income. Members are charged with ensuring community safety and it will be difficult to ensure that mission if the Board cannot attract and keep qualified, competent members.

It is proposed that the Arizona Board of Executive Clemency Board members be funded at midpoint salary range or \$65,544.73 within the classification "Board Member" Grade 23. This pay level recognizes the complexity of the work and is commensurate to the critical decision making compared to other jobs with similar responsibilities in criminal justice.
